

2022-2023 Community Grant Program

Our Mission: The Junior League of Lancaster (JLL) is an organization of women whose mission is to advance women's leadership for meaningful community impact through volunteer action, collaboration, and training. Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable.

The JLL is a vibrant organization striving make a positive and sustained impact in our community. The JLL Community Grant Program seeks to further the League's current Issue-Based Community Impact (IBCI) focus area of Health, Nutrition, and Food Insecurity.

The 2022-2023 Community Grant Program will award grants to Lancaster non-profits that address health, nutrition, and food insecurity within our community. The grants will be \$1,400.00 each, and must be directly connected to amplifying the existing work of the League's current initiative.

Evaluation Criteria

- Must be a Lancaster County non-profit organization or non-profit that focuses on health, nutrition, nutrition education, and food insecurity projects within the community.
- Must have a current or proposed project that supports the health, nutrition and food insecurity focus area for the year 2023.

Program Requirements

- Check-in at the start of the program, report upon competition of the program.
- Funds may not be used for:
 - Debt reduction, operating deficits, interim or bridge funding or endowment funding
 - Private foundations
 - Activities that are religious or political in nature
 - Fund drives, annual appeals, fundraising events, or general capital campaigns
- Funds must be used within 6 months.

Application Requirements

- Organization Information
 - Non-profit status documentation
 - Organization's mission statement
 - o Brief overview of the organization and evidence of its impact
- Additional Details
 - Full proposal, including the organization's plan and timeline for implementing the funds for which grant monies will be used.
 - If health, nutrition, and food insecurity is not the entirety of the non-profit mission, please provide information pertaining to the food insecurity-based programming that is offered.
 - The number of projects that the organization plans to implement for 2023.

 - Grant applications will be accepted beginning Monday, May 1, 2023.
 - All application materials must be received by Monday, May 15, 2023.
 - o Grants will be awarded by Monday, May 22, 2023.
