JUNIOR LEAGUE OF LANCASTER TO HOST 15TH ANNUAL RUN4LUCK MARCH 14

LANCASTER, PA (Feb. 4, 2020) – Calling all runners and walkers! Celebrate St. Patrick’s Day at the Junior League of Lancaster’s 15th annual Run4Luck, Saturday, March 14, at Lancaster Country Day School (725 Hamilton Rd., Lancaster).

Visit <https://runsignup.com/Race/PA/Lancaster/Run4Luck> to register to attend this family-friendly event, which includes a 4-mile run, 2-mile walk, and a kids’ fun run.

Early-bird registration is available now through Feb. 27. The cost for individual runners is \$25 and \$22 for team runners and those participating in the 2-mile walk. Those who register by Feb. 27 are guaranteed the early-bird registration price, a long-sleeved performance shirt and race bag. Registration will remain open after Feb. 27 until race day at \$35 for individual runners and \$25 for team runners and 2-mile walk participants. Registration for the Kids’ Fun Run is \$10.

“Run4Luck is a signature Junior League of Lancaster event and has been a Lancaster staple for the last 15 years,” said Libby Caldwell, 2019-2020 Junior League president. “The run supports the Junior League in the pursuit of its mission of improving the community through the ongoing development of women as trained volunteers. Junior League members give of their time and expertise to support community organizations and projects such as the Hands-on House, the North Museum, Lancaster Science Factory, Arch Street Center, Youth Intervention Center, New Choices, and more.”

Local radio personality Holly Love will kick off the event starting with the kids’ fun run at 9 a.m., the 4-mile run at 9:30 a.m., and the 2-mile walk at 9:40 a.m.

After the annual run and walk, participants are invited to enjoy post-race festivities including an awards ceremony, music, and fun. Top male and female finishers in the 4-mile race will be awarded medals. Additional prizes will be awarded for the team with the most festive St. Patrick’s Day costumes.

Race bags and runner bibs will be available for pickup 3-7 p.m. Friday, March 13, at Lancaster Country Day School, or on race day starting at 8 a.m. in the registration tent.
